IGU has since September 2006 implemented a secondee programme, giving the IGU members the opportunity to second a young person with knowledge and interest for the energy sector to the IGU Secretariat. The assignment should last for at least one year and be considered to be a part of a career development programme.

The experience has been very positive both for the seconded person and for the Secretariat. In the April 2009 edition of the IGU Magazine on page 36 you may read a short report from Barbara Schmid, the first person seconded to IGU under this programme. You can also find this edition of the Magazine on the web site: www.igu.org.

The programme has since the initial start been expanded, and we now have capacity for two seconded persons in the IGU Secretariat.

Currently we have with us Florijana Dedovic from Plinacro, Croatia who has worked in the Secretariat since April 2008, and Jeanet van Dellen from Gasunie, Netherlands who started her assignment in February 2009. Florijana will conclude her assignment at the end of 2009, while Jeanet will continue till February 2011. Therefore, we are pleased to invite members to nominate candidates for an assignment of a secondee starting early in 2010.

The candidate for secondment must be a young person, who is capable of working in an English speaking and writing environment as well as being used to work in small teams.

Since this is part of a career development plan on the part of the employer of the candidate, the Secretary General of IGU will ensure that the secondee will work within a broad range of issues, such as finance, promotional activities, meeting and conference arrangements, and the IGU Knowledge centre. The work will give exposure to a global membership community and a unique insight to the world's gas industry.

The IGU Member seconding a person to the Secretariat, will continue to be the main employer of the secondee, paying the salary and all other benefits as well as expatriate cost as agreed between them.



IGU will provide the necessary office accommodation with work station in the Secretariat and any cost of travel and accommodation on behalf of IGU.

If you are interested in learning more about this possibility or actually have a candidate for such secondment, please contact the IGU Secretariat. For planning purposes it would be appreciated that any expression of interest - also without any commitment - could reach us before 1 August 2009.

The secondment programme has been very successful, and I would like to invite you all to consider this opportunity for your company or association.
